**Qualifications:**

Accomplished rider. Western or English and bareback. Riding in halter/lead rope/hackamore/full bridle.

- Accomplished with Parelli training method, Level 2 minimum. Ground work at Serenity is paramount. (training must have been with Certified Parelli Instructor)
- Certification from EAGALA as Equine specialist or Mental Health, or OK Corral organizations.
- PATH, Intl. certification
- Good communication skills and interpersonal skills. The ability to communicate with the Executive Director, instructors and volunteers in a respectful, professional and friendly manner.
- Professional appearance and conduct manner. Adaptable and flexible when needed. Calm under stress.
- Strong, effective leadership skills.
- Experience working with people exercising a positive attitude with great results.
- Horse management includes health and safety knowledge.
- Strong willingness to stay current with CEU's.

**Areas of Responsibilities:**

- Work alongside Executive Director, Instructors and horse handlers where programs are concerned.
- Weekly exercise schedule for all program horses, appropriate to each horse.
- Instruct classes of therapeutic riding, facilitate EAL sessions and go out on Team Thunder.
- **Seasonal Part-time position: 20 hours a week March through October per year. More hours may be available to the right person with multiple skills set.**
