- Familiar with Parelli training method. Best candidate would be one who has attended more than one clinic with professional instructor and has accomplished levels 1 and 2.
- Current certification with either PATH or CHA and in good standings.
- Good communication skills and interpersonal skills. The ability to communicate with all staff and volunteers in a respectful, professional and friendly manner.
- Professional appearance and conduct a must. Adaptable and flexible when needed. Calm under tough situations.
- Strong, effective leadership skills.
- Experience within a team, exercising positive attitude with great results.
- Strong willingness to stay current with CEU's.
- A real plus would be for potential candidate to be familiar with EAGALA or OK Corral and have at least one certification of experience.
